Please keep in mind, all delegates and alternates to the District NYI Convention must be members of the local Church of the Nazarene. The number of delegates elected & sent to the convention should be in proportion to the number of NYI members reported on the pastor's report for the church year that just ended. We've included a table from the NYI Global Charter that should be helpful:
